### Galatians 4:4-5


For so many the Christmas season and

celebration ends up like the boxes strewn across the floor—empty. Christmas is about giving and receiving gifts, but its focus is not on the gifts and presents placed under a tree. The focus of Christmas is a baby who is God in human flesh placed in a manger.

Christmas is the celebration of the gift of God's one and only Son, a gift he gave to the world. It's the gift that I need, that you need, that this whole world needs. You see, this world—including you and me—is wrapped and covered in sin. It's this covering of sin that leaves us empty and disappointed and looking for more gifts and other presents that we hope will fill the void. But they can't.

It is only through the gift of God's Son, and his life and death that removes from you the ugly covering and wrapping of your sins. Jesus did not come to be placed under a Christmas tree, but to hang upon a tree, not as an orna-

ment, but as the one who would die upon it to pay for all of your sins. His perfect, innocent life and death are gifts he offers to you to make you his perfect and holy child and heir of heaven.

This month, we at LOTW will begin a drive to benefit the Fairbanks Rescue Mission, a local shelter for homeless families and individual adults. We will have collection boxes set up in the main entry at church for the month of December to accept donations of KITCH-EN NEEDS (nonperishable) items such as oatmeal, pancake mix, syrup. powdered milk; SHELTER NEEDS such as diapers (all sizes), laundry detergent, razors, shaving cream; and OFFICE NEEDS

such as letter-size copy paper, ink pens. scotch tape for dispensers. A list of items is posted with the boxes. Since the staff prepares three meals a day for 100 people, large sizes are greatly appreciated. Thank you for helping with this worthy cause!


