This year's VBS theme is one that you can easily remember. It takes the classic Christmas hymn, "Go, Tell It on the Mountain," and applies it to each child, how they can tell others that Jesus Christ is the Lord. In a way, this year's Vacation Bible School is teaching these young children not only who their Savior is, but it's also preparing them to go out and share that same good news with others.

That's what Jesus did for his disciples throughout his ministry as well. Maybe you're like Elijah, who tried to hide in a cave because he thought he was the only one left who believed in God and because he was afraid of how others would hurt him if they didn't like his message. Is that your fear, ruining relationships or making others mad at you because you want to share your faith with them?

Or maybe you're like Moses, who tried to come up with every excuse in the book. I'm not worthy. I don't know what to say. I can't speak well. Those are common excuses for us as well.

None of those excuses matter to God. He's given you the most precious gift, your salvation, and wants you to share it with others. He gives you and me the message of Jesus and his love to go and tell others.


