We need to spend every day being prepared, being ready for Jesus to come back. But so often, we're not. Maybe it's the attitude, "I'm betting Jesus won't be coming back anytime soon, so I can always get ready tomorrow." Or maybe, you get so caught up in the world and all its busyness that you don't have time to think about Jesus' return.

The worst thing that could happen for any of us is to be ill -prepared when Jesus returns because then we run the risk of missing out on joining him in his heavenly kingdom. Thankfully, though, where we sin and fall short in our preparations for the end of the world, God forgives us. Food Collection


