## *Your Freedom Is Free!*

***“So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.”  
John 8:53***

“Freedom is never free.” I’m guessing you’ve probably heard that phrase before, probably even around this time of year. Besides the typical family gatherings, the delicious cookouts, and the breath-taking fireworks displays (in the Outside; I’m not advocating shooting fireworks in these dry conditions!), the 4<sup>th</sup> of July is a holiday where you can take some time and remember and be thankful for the freedoms we enjoy today.


