But unfortunately, time stopped the moment I had to read out loud in front of my classmates. After that, I would shut down when I was asked to read. That is, until my fourth grade teacher treated me differently. She gave me special reading assignments to do on my own. I got my confidence back because one teacher looked at me differently.

That is essentially what Jesus has done for us. We have stut-

tered our way through life, giving into our sinful desires. God has every right to call us what we are: spiritual screwups who deserve to be separated from him. But like my fourth grade teacher, God looks at us as if we were good people who do the right thing. He sees us this way because we are covered with Jesus' love and forgiveness. As our substitute, Jesus was treated like a sinner on the cross, so now we are treated like a saint. The more we realize that God looks at us as good people through Jesus, the more we will start acting like it.


